3 Nov 19.00-23.00	<b>Trattoria*</b> Trattoria is a guerrilla restaurant that appears for one night only in unexpected places around the world. Every part of it, from the cutlery to the kitchen, food and furniture, is entirely designed and prepared by åbåke especially for the event. The night is hosted by Martino Gamper and Alex Rich.
4 Nov 10.00-18.00	<b>Design without Label</b> Afternoon visitors can book 10 minute personal tutorials with Åbåke on the topic 'Design without Label'. In the morning visitors can observe a Royal College of Art tutorial on the same subject.
5 Nov 10.00-18.00	<b>Yellow pages Bonfire</b> Michael Needham hosts a bonfire night celebration with a recycling theme – don't bin your old Yellow pages, bring them along and add them to the pile in ION Square Gardens, E3.

They will prepare simple food underneath the screen and serve it to the audience during the showing of a double bill: <i>Werner Herzog Eats His Shoe</i> and Errol Morris's <i>Gates of Heaven</i> , a documentary about the pet cemetery business.
8 Nov 10.00-18.00	<b>On Purpose link</b> åbåke team up with the organisers of the <i>On Purpose: Design Concepts</i> exhibition at Arnolfini in Bristol, to create a two-way virtual tour of both exhibitions. <i>On Purpose</i> includes work by åbåke, Alex Rich, Onkar Kular and Noam Toran.
9 Nov 10.00-18.00	<b>Aurélien Froment</b> An exhibition by artist Aurélien Froment offering the opportunity to buy a book that has not yet been created.
10 Nov 10.00-18.00	<b>School 2</b> The inaugural faculty meeting of School 2, a group of ten people including åbåke members and their friends. Each of the school's members will teach a different subject to their classmates in a series of meetings. Visitors will help them decide on the school's programme. All day £1 bar.
11 Nov 10.00-18.00	<b>Design without Label</b> Afternoon visitors can book 10 minute personal tutorials with åbåke on the topic 'Design without Label'. In the morning visitors can see Royal College of Art students' formal presentations on the subject from previous tutorials.

14 Nov 10.00-18.00	<b>Le Look Fordham with Ludivine Billaud and Man Somerlink</b> Curator Man Somerlink and the Fordham Gallery will occupy the studio for a series of debates and conversations about the future of the art space. All day £1 bar.
