

COVID-19 safety and security at Somerset House

Key information for event organisers and attendees

The health and wellbeing of our event guests, event organisers, suppliers and venue staff is our number one priority. Somerset House has introduced a number of measures across the site to help everyone remain safe while they're here.

To ensure your visit to Somerset House is safe, we ask you follow the below measures.



- If you, anyone you live with or anyone you've recently been in contact with is feeling unwell and showing symptoms, please stay at home and follow current government advice on self-isolating. If you feel unwell on site, please let a member of staff know.
- Ensure the event organiser has the correct contact information for you. Should we be required to contact you in the event of an outbreak of Covid-19, we will use the information provided by the event organiser.



- Hand sanitiser and hand washing facilities will be available throughout Somerset House. Wash your hands regularly and for at least 20 seconds.



- Currently, members of the public can enter Somerset House via the Strand or the River Terrace entrances only.
- Where possible walk or cycle to Somerset House.



- Please maintain a safe social distance from other guests and staff.
- Face coverings are required within the building. Face coverings are not mandatory in outdoor areas.
- We will be operating one way systems around the building.
- Toilet facilities will be available. These toilets will be self-contained cubicles or there will be a limit on the number of individuals in these facilities at any one time to ensure social distancing.



- Please be kind, considerate and respect the safety of others by following these guidelines.

We are following the official Working Safely during Covid-19 Government guidance to make sure the whole building is Covid secure for staff and visitors. This is an ongoing process and will be updated as government advice changes.
