UEFA Champions Festival
Celebrating Football and Community Engagement at Somerset House

OBJECTIVES

The UEFA Champions Festival was an extensive four-day event hosted at Somerset House alongside four other central London locations from 30 May to 2 June 2024. The festival was created to celebrate the UEFA Champions League Final coming to London, with a range of activities designed to engage football fans and the local community.

Key objectives of the activation included showcasing football excellence, engaging the community, supporting charities and promoting London as a premier event destination for large scale events.

Somerset House was hand-picked to host the Champions Pitch due to its:


- Iconic Grade I listed building, setting and backdrop in Central London which has a rich history \ and cultural significance


